- Art. 1)** The competition is open to young Ballet Talents between the ages of 11 - 26 years old of any nationality. All Participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or teacher.
- Art. 2)** **Thursday** March 16th, 2017 **First Round**- participants will attend a ballet class according to category. Contemporary class for Juniors, Seniors & Semi-Professionals. **Friday** 17th, March **Second Round**- participants will perform their variations. **Saturday** morning March 18th, participants will perform the variations ***chosen by the jury on stage in costume.*** **Saturday** evening at 9 P.M. Gala performance **PART ONE.** **Sunday** March 19th at 4 P.M. Gala Performance **PART TWO** and awarding of prizes and scholarships. **All participants MUST be present.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GROUPS

“ CANADIAN GRAND PRIX ”

Art 1) Opened to all students of any nationality between the ages 7 (born in 2009) and 26 years of age .

CATAGORIES:

Pre-Competitive	Ages 7 – 12
Juniors	Ages 13 - 15
Seniors	Ages 16 - 18
Semi-Professional	Ages 19 - 26

All participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a Parent, Guardian or Teacher.

Art. 2) Thursday March 16th, First Round- participants will attend a ballet class according to category. Contemporary class for Juniors, Seniors & Semi-Professionals.

Friday March 17th, Second Round- participants will perform their group choreographies .

Saturday morning March 18th, participants will perform their group choreography on stage in costume.

Saturday evening at 9 P.M. Gala performance PART ONE.

Sunday March 19th at 4 P.M. Gala Performance PART TWO and awarding of prizes and scholarships. **All participants MUST be present.**

Art 3) The choreographies may be in any discipline of Dance. Choreographies from Classical Ballet Repertory may not be used, all choreographies must be designed for the group. The choreographies must not be longer than 6 min.

Art 4) Registration Fee: € 50. 00 not refundable by **20th February, 2017,** after that date € 70. 00

Art 5) Participation Fee:

Group with 3-5 members	€ 30. 00 per participant
Group with 6-10 members	€ 25. 00 per participant
Group with 11-or more	€ 20. 00 per participant

Art 6) For those schools that present more than one Group a 10% discount will be applied on the fee for the second choreography.

SOLOISTS AND GROUPS – For those who wish, once the Registration Fee has been paid the remaining Participation Fee may be accepted the afternoon of March 15th, 2017 . Payments must be made by Certified Check in Euro or Cash, personal checks will not be accepted.
